

The Color Wheel Challenge



The idea is simple... gather items in bright, solid colours from around your home, assemble them into color wheel order, and snap a pic! Then share your creation on class Dojo, Teams or our Twitter account @NottmPrimary

Here are a few tips...

1. Start assembling your colour wheel as you find things.
2. Using something round as a **template** is helpful.
3. You can put a round mat or plate in the middle to hold that space open and then remove it for a photo. It can be easier than trying to make all the colours angle into the middle but go for it if you are feeling ambitious!
4. I liked having brown in the middle, because when you mix all the colours together, they make.... brown! But that is optional, of course.
5. Make sure you get the colours in the right order (*not* optional!) Just remember ROYGBP (red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple).
6. Check your work by making sure the complimentary colours are across from each other.... red should be across from green, orange across from blue, and yellow across from purple. (Fun fact: If you mix any two complimentary colours together you get brown!)
7. Take your picture from higher up than you think you need to, holding the camera level, and then **crop** it to a tight square.
8. Try not to get **too** carried away collecting things.... remember, you have to put it all back!
