Home School Packs

Here are some fun activities for your child to do during school closures:

- * Make an Easter basket: Ask a grown up to help read the instructions on how to make your Easter basket. You can use some of the pom-poms and other materials we have provided to decorate them. When it is finished maybe ask a grown up to take a photograph and stick it in your home-school book.
- * <u>Hand-washing:</u> Ask a grown up to read with you and talk to you about the hand washing instructions poster. Ask a grown up to stick this near to the sink that you wash your hands in. Can you remember the song we said you need to sing whilst washing your hands? Why is it important to wash your hands?
- Musycling: Don't just put your empty cartons and boxes into the recycling bin. Ask a grown up to help you read how to make your own 'Musycling' instrument using recycled materials! What type of instrument is it, drum, shaker, guitar? Can you play this whilst singing some of your favourite songs?
- * <u>Bunny Hop:</u> Can you trace over the lines to make the bunny hop and travel in different ways? Think carefully about how to hold your pencil using 'Peter Pointer', 'Tommy Thumb' and 'Toby Tall' remember we don't grab a pencil with all our fingers!
- Plant a Bean: We have provided a small bag with a paper towels and beans inside for you to plant a bean in and watch it grow. Ask a grown up to help read the instructions on how to do this. There is also a bean diary for you to complete as you watch your bean grow. You can either draw a picture of the changes you see happening to your bean or ask a grown up to take a photograph of you and your bean as it grows and stick this into your bean diary. Tell your grown up what changes you can see happening and ask them to write this down in your bean diary.
- Magic Bean Countdown: Ask a grown up to read the Magic Bean Countdown rhyme to you, or if you have our class DoJo set up, watch the video of Mrs Eastwell singing the rhyme. Can you colour in the magic beans? Cut them out and see if you can retell the rhyme using your beans.
- * Exercise Book: We have given all the children an exercise book. During the time we may be closed, this is for your child to draw or record anything they wish to or of any photographs of any activities they complete during our time of closure.
- Class Dojo: For all of those who have provided us with a current e-mail address we will set up you up with our Class Dojo. Using this we will be sending out daily videos of staff singing songs and rhymes and stories for the children to enjoy and help to engage with some activities at home.
