With your writing ensure that you include words that will help people know you are thinking about them. It's a good idea to draft your poster first as you may change your mind. Have a look at my ideas below!




Writing Letters to Our Community -


When writing your letters make sure your handwriting and the presentation is as good as it would be at school, we are all really good at handwriting in our school so try to apply your skills.
