## Place Value

Children need to understand to value of each digit in a 2 -digit number (e.g. 32 - where 3 means 30 and 2 means 2 ).

They need to know how many tens and ones are in each number.

## Questions for your child about 2 digit numbers

Give an example of a 2 digit number and ask them:
$\leftrightarrows$ What is one more and one less than a number?
$\hookrightarrow$ Is the number odd or even?
$\breve{C}$ Can you tell me a number which is less than $\qquad$ ?
$\leftrightarrows$ Can you tell me a number which is more than $\qquad$ ?
$\hookrightarrow$ Can your child compare numbers? Ask your child to order numbers from smallest to greatest or greatest to smallest (e.g. 22, 18, $29=18,22,29$ )
$\leftrightarrows$ Is the number in the 2 times table?
$\leftrightarrows$ Why? (the number ends in a $0,2,4,6$ or 8 )
$\leftrightarrows$ Is the number in the 5 times table?
$\hookrightarrow$ Why? (the number ends in a 0 or 5 )
$\leftrightarrows$ Is the number in the 10 times table?
$\hookrightarrow$ Why (the number ends in a 0 )
