Place Value

Children need to understand the value of each digit in a 2-digit number (e.g. 32 – where 3 means 30 and 2 means 2).

They need to know how many tens and ones are in each number.

Questions for your child about 2 digit numbers

Give an example of a 2 digit number and ask them:

- ↪ What is one more and one less than a number?
- ↪ Is the number odd or even?
- ↪ Can you tell me a number which is less than _____?
- ↪ Can you tell me a number which is more than _____?
- ↪ Can your child compare numbers? Ask your child to order numbers from smallest to greatest or greatest to smallest
(e.g. 22, 18, 29 = 18, 22, 29)
- ↪ Is the number in the 2 times table?
 - ↪ Why? (the number ends in a 0, 2, 4, 6 or 8)
- ↪ Is the number in the 5 times table?
 - ↪ Why? (the number ends in a 0 or 5)
- ↪ Is the number in the 10 times table?
 - ↪ Why (the number ends in a 0)
