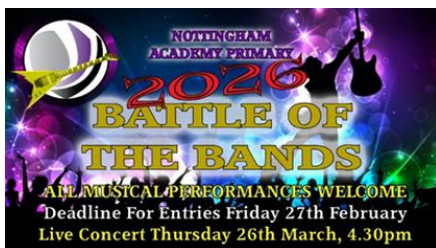
Y2- Fire Engine Visit!
