Uniform Expectations

As we begin the new academic year, we'd like to remind families of the importance of wearing the correct school uniform each day (please see below). Uniforms help create a sense of belonging and pride in our school community and ensure all children are dressed appropriately for learning and play. We understand that circumstances can sometimes make this challenging, and we're here to support you—please don't hesitate to contact the school office if you need any help with uniform items or have any concerns. We want to help all of our children and parents feel part of our school.

The uniform for all pupils (Nursery through to Year 6) comprises:

- Academy polo t-shirt with logo or plain white polo t-shirt
- Grey or black trousers or skirt or pinafore dress (jeans and cords are not allowed)
- Academy sweatshirt or cardigan, in purple, with the Academy logo or a plain purple sweatshirt or cardigan
- Grey or black socks with trousers, white socks or grey / black tights with skirts
- One book bag or backpack
- One PE bag

PE Kit:

- Black shorts with the Academy logo or plain black shorts or jogging bottoms
- Purple sports polo shirt with black panels and Academy logo or a plain black t-shirt
- Suitable trainers or other PE footwear

Parents are asked to provide:

- Sensible black shoes (no boots or trainers)
- Suitable footwear for PE
- A warm coat (no denim) for travelling to and from the Academy
